

## The Correct Sequence

1. Dust
2. Stir well
3. Dip
4. Sponge
5. Patch
6. Squirt
7. Label
8. Place on shelf
9. Clean table and bucket lids

## Do

- Wax high enough (1/4 inch)
- Keep the dust rags clean
- Rub bottom of bucket when you stir glaze
- Stir well
- Squeegee hands before washing them
- Dip quickly
- If doing a half-and-half dip, keep the overlap narrow Use two non runny glazes. As your skills improve you can use a somewhat runny with a non runny. Never a runny glaze.
- Use runny glazes appropriately (only use on inside of bowls and lips of tall pots)
- When squirting, apply a thick bead
- Keep a notebook. Put your name in it. Record what you do and glaze combos you like. Sketch ideas,
- Sponge a clean line on foot, up 1/4 inch
- Use boards when you can't reach the Formica table
- Clean tables and lids when done

## Don't

- Knock glaze off the side of the bucket while stirring, it makes lumps
- Splash peoples pots
- Squirt on the outside of pots
- Don't use a two somewhat fluid glazes on a half an half dip
- Ever use runny glazes on the outside of pots
